

DISC REPLACEMENT

WHAT IS CERVICAL ARTHOPLASTY?

CERVICAL ARTHROPLASTY IS A SUGERY THAT REPLACES A DISC IN THE NECK OR BACK WITH AN ARTIFICIAL DISC.

IT IS AN ALTERNATIVE TO CERVICAL FUSION WHOSE CHEIF BENEFIT IS THE PRESERVATION OF FULL RANGE OF MOTION IN THE NECK OR BACK.



THE NECK WILL MAINTAIN
ITS NATURAL MOVEMENT IN
FLEXION, EXTENSION AND
ROTATION. THIS ALSO OFFERS
INSTANT STABILITY
WITHOUT FUSING THE NECK.







ARTHROPLASTY VS. FUSION



DISC REPLACEMENT IS A **LESS INVASIVE** SURGERY, REDUCING SURGICAL RISKS, PAIN AND BLOOD LOSS

DISC REPLACEMENT RECOVERY TIME IS NEARLY

ONE QUARTER THAT OF NECK FUSION OPERATION
